

FIRST-EVER POWERBOAT RALLY IS COMING TO LA PAZ

FUBAR ODYSSEY 2007 will be crossing the
Finish Line at Marina CostaBaja in November

The first-ever powerboat rally from San Diego to La Paz Mexico, FUBAR ODYSSEY 2007, is gearing up for a November 7th departure. Planned by Del Rey Yacht Club in partnership with Mexico's Tourism Board and intended to provide a supportive and fun environment to introduce powerboat owners to the enjoyment of cruising in Mexico, this extraordinary rally has 60 yachts signed up to make the trip; additional yachts had to be turned away because the organizers set the limit at 60.

Participants in the rally will be escorted by vessels manned by experienced skippers and with the key support people aboard such as mechanics, doctors, paramedics and boat manufacturers and by the makers of major marine engines, electronics and equipment. Also on hand will be the exciting 86-foot Cadenza, the first diesel electric American yacht built by a production builder.

Safe routes will be pre-planned, and a weather routing service has signed on to oversee the entire trip. Stops along the way include Ensenada for fueling at optimum prices and clearing into Mexico, Turtle Bay for re-fueling, Santa Maria, Magdalena Bay, Cabo San Jose, Muertos Bay, and ending in La Paz.

The finish line will include a closing ceremony and festive party at Marina CostaBaja, one of the major sponsors of FUBAR ODYSSEY 2007. Due north of the north end of La Paz Channel, the new Marina CostaBaja, part of CostaBaja Resort & Marina, is the nearest one to the Sea of Cortez and has quickly earned the reputation as the best on the West Coast.

With 250 prime slips for vessels of 30 to 200 feet, guests at Marina CostaBaja are enjoying its top quality amenities, which include a state-of-the-art pump-out system servicing each slip, concrete Bellingham Marine docks, wireless telephone, Internet access, metered electricity and desalinated water hook-ups at each slip plus crew lounge with satellite television, Internet access, restrooms and showers, secure dock boxes with integrated lighting, fuel dock on premises, and 24-hour staffing and security.

The 120-room Fiesta Inn Hotel, conveniently located between the basins, provides free access for marina tenants to its two pools, fitness center, business center with guest computers, restaurant, and bar. The picturesque Pueblo Marinero, the village that surrounds the inner basin, has shops, galleries, and several outstanding restaurants in a lovely shaded courtyard area overlooking the marina.
